





William Shakespeare is probably the most famous writer in the world and responsible for creating many words and phrases used in the modern English language. As well as English lessons, see Shakespeare's plays at the famous Globe Theatre in London and an outdoor performance in one of Cambridge University's college gardens as part of the annual Cambridge Shakespeare festival. You can also visit his birthplace and attend a performance at the Royal Shakespeare Company's theatre in Stratford-upon Avon.
